

Witkowski Named Honorable Mention All-UMAC

Sophomore wing **Emily Witkowski** *(Michigan LHS)* was named Honorable Mention All-UMAC by the conference on Monday.

Witkowski led the Knights in scoring (13.0 points per game) and finished eighth in the conference with an average of 14.6 points per game during UMAC play. Witkowski also led MLC in rebounds per game (5.3) and three-point field goals (40).

Witkowski finished the season strong, scoring at least 20 points four times in her last nine games, including a career-high 27 points in a 69-58 win over Crown College in the final week of the season.
