The sprinters also got into the act, as **Joshuah Kren** (*WISCO*), **Evan Turriff** (*LPS*), **Urvin Lewis** (*LPS*), and **Micah Jarvis** (*LPS*) joined to take second in the 4x100 Meter Relay. Jarvis and Kren also recorded strong finishes in the 100 Meters and 200 Meters, respectively.
