Alison Lindemann Named Player of the Week

Senior Alison Lindemann (LPS) was named UMAC Women's Golf Player of the Week on Monday.

Lindemann was the Knights' top performer in three different tournaments last week, and defeated 33 other golfers at the North Central Invite on September 17 with a season-best round of 85.

Lindemann averaged a score of 90 in the three events last week. She took second place against Bethany Lutheran in the annual Saxony Cup match with a score of 91 on September 19, and added a third-place finish at the UMN Invite hosted by Minnesota Morris on September 20 with a round of 94.

Senior men's golfer **Zackary Zuberbier** (*Milwaukee WI*) continued his strong start to the season over three events last week.

Zuberbier's best performance came on September 19 when he took first place in the annual Wittenberg Cup match against Bethany Lutheran. Zuberbier's winning score of 76 helped the Knights win the team event over the Vikings for the first time since the 2015 season.

Zuberbier also tied for fourth place at the UMN Invite on September 20, and opened the week with a tie for seventh at the North Central Invite on September 16. Through the first seven rounds this season, Zuberbier is averaging a career-low score of 78, and has finished in the top five in five of the Knights' six events.
