

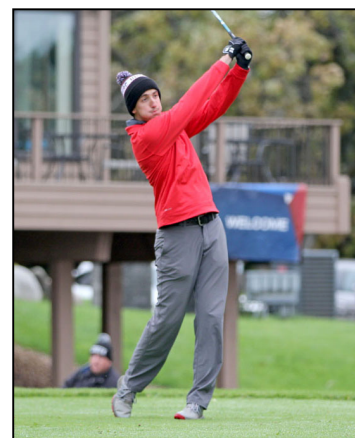


## Zuberbier Leads Golf Team at Twin Ports Collegiate

Senior **Zackary Zuberbier** (*Milwaukee WI*) led the men's golf team to a fourth-place finish in the season-opening Twin Ports Collegiate tournament last weekend.

Zuberbier fired a two-round score of 150 at the weekend event, capped by a career-best round of 73 on Saturday. That score was good for a sixth-place tie in the final individual standings out of 47 golfers at the event, and helped the men take fourth out of eight teams at the tournament.

Senior **Alison Lindemann** (*LPS*) led the women with a two-day score of 188 to help the Knights to an eighth-place finish.

## Men's Soccer Rolls to 8-0 Win

The men's soccer team capped a busy opening weekend of competition with an 8-0 win over Nebraska Christian College on Monday.

**Nathan Lemke** (*Lakeside*), **Joe Graumann** (*Lakeside*), and **Luke Meihack** (*WLA*) scored in the first half to give the Knights a 3-0 lead, while **Mark Burger** (*MLS*), **Caleb Koelpin** (*LPS*), **Lucas Martin** (*LPS*), and **Noah Schaewe** (*HVL*) each scored in the second half. The goals by Lemke, Koelpin, Martin, and Schaewe were the first collegiate goals for each player.

The Knights opened the season on Friday, August 30, with a 2-2 tie at Buena Vista. MLC trailed 2-1 late in regulation before Graumann scored from outside the box in the 90th minute to force extra time.
