The football team continued its hot start to UMAC play with a 51-6 win over Iowa Wesleyan in last weekend's Homecoming game.

The Knights scored two touchdowns in each quarter on offense, while the defense held its second straight opponent under 100 total yards. **Joshuah Kren** (*WISCO*) and **Elliott Butler** (*Lakeside*) each scored a pair of touchdowns, while quarterback **Ethan Aguilar** (*CLHS*) threw for two scores and ran for another in the win.

Tristan Pankow (*MLS*) led the defensive effort with seven tackles, including one sack. **Joe Herrewig** (*WLA*) and **Noah Nordlie** (*MLS*) each intercepted a pass.

Senior Joe Graumann (Lakeside) led the men's soccer team to a 2-1 win over

Minnesota Morris on October 15 with a pair of goals. The win improved the Knights to 2-3 in UMAC play with three conference games remaining on the schedule.

Graumann opened the scoring midway through the first half on a header following a **Clay Hirsch** *(LPS)* corner kick, and then scored the game winner in the 88th minute

Graumann leads the Knights and ranks fourth in the UMAC with eight goals this season, and his two tallies against the Cougars tied him with Karl Valleskey ('03) for fourth place in MLC men's soccer program history in career goals (36) and career
