Balanced Offense Leads Knights to 41-20 Win

The football team continued its unbeaten UMAC season with a 41-20 win over Northwestern on October 26.

The Knights showed off their balanced offensive attack with 475 total yards (243 rushing, 232 passing) in the game. Quarterback **Ethan Aguilar** (*CLHS*) threw for three touchdowns to lead the way. Running backs **Austin DeNoyer** (*Lakeside*) and **Joshuah Kren** (*WISCO*) combined for 206 rushing yards and 124 receiving yards.

Ian Paulsen (*LPS*) led the defensive effort with nine tackles, one sack (which went for a safety), and a blocked field goal. **Aiden Holien** (*GPLHS*) intercepted two passes.

MLC dominated the Storm throughout the game, taking 21 shots on goal while allowing only three. **Nicole Porter** (*MVL*) opened the scoring in the 31st minute off her own rebound. **Emily Witkowski** (*Michigan LHS*) and **Erika Rosenbaum** (*Michigan LHS*) added goals in the second half to secure the win.

Keeper **Mollie Fischer** (*Shoreland*) stopped all three Crown shots on the way to her sixth shutout of the season.
