Volleyball Tops Northland in Four

The volleyball team defeated Northland 3-1 (25-17, 17-25, 28-26, 25-21) on Saturday to move to 1-1 in UMAC play this season.

The Knights won a back-and-forth third set by the score of 28-26 to take a 2-1 lead in the match, and then put Northland away in the fourth and final set to secure the win.

Hannah Willems (*Lakeside*) led MLC with 10 kills and two blocks, while **Kaylie Solomon** (*MLS*) added eight kills while committing only one error. **Kate Aswege** (*KMLHS*) recorded a team-best 15 digs. **Kati Aguilar** (*CLHS*) finished with three service aces to go with her seven kills.

The football team played well on both sides of the ball in a 27-6 win at previously unbeaten St. Scholastica on Saturday.

The Knights ran for 402 yards on 75 carries on offense as both **Austin DeNoyer** (*Lakeside*) and **Joshuah Kren** (*WISCO*) went over 100 yards on the ground. The offensive line of **Derek Gulrud** (*Lakeside*), **Alex Quist** (*St. Peter MN*), **Sam Boeder** (*MVL*), **Carrington Cunningham** (*WISCO*), and **Andrew Owczarzak** (*MLS*) was named to the D3football.com Team of the Week following the game.

The defense held the Saints to only 84 total yards and one score. **Marquise Jackson-Hunter** (*Milwaukee WI*) led a defensive front that sacked CSS eight times and recorded 15 tackles for loss, while **Ian Paulsen** (*LPS*) intercepted two passes.
