



Buege Takes Fifth at UMAC Championships

First-year runner **Abigail Buege** (*LPS*) was named First Team All-UMAC after a fifth-place showing over the weekend at the UMAC Cross Country Championships.

Buege finished in a time of 24:42.2, and her fifth-place finish was the best by an MLC women's cross country runner at the event since Robin Nommensen ('13) took fourth place in 2011.

Buege's finish led the MLC women to a fifth-place finish in the team standings. The men took fourth place, led by top-20 finishes by **Ethan Carter** (*LPS*), **Jacob Melso** (*LPS*), and **Ryan Maertz** (*GPLHS*).

The men's soccer team fell behind in the opening minute of its UMAC Postseason Tournament quarterfinal game at Northland College, but scored three times in the second half to advance to Wednesday's semifinal round.

The Knights trailed 1-0 at halftime, but **Nate Lemke** (*Lakeside*) scored just 22 seconds into the second half to tie the game 1-1, and **Joe Graumann** (*Lakeside*) added the game-winner on a breakaway in the 64th minute. **Xander Heiman** (*LPS*) scored an important insurance goal in the 87th minute to help the Knights hold on for the win down the stretch.

The win sends the Knights to conference champion UW-Superior in the semifinal round. MLC lost 2-1 in overtime to the Yellowjackets during the regular season.
