Wheaton had not allowed any team to rush for more than 85 yards in a game this season, and held the Knights' elite rushing attack to 156 yards for the game. The Thunder also took advantage of four MLC turnovers.

Joshuah Kren (WISCO) scored on a 44-yard run to account for the Knights' points in the game. Kren finished the game with 107 total yards (67 rushing, 40 receiving).
