The women's basketball team scored a big win over Northland College by the score of 75-65 on Saturday.

Defense led the way for MLC as it held Northland to just 23.8 percent shooting overall and 11.1 percent (4-36) shooting from beyond the three-point arc. The Knights also forced 20 turnovers that turned into 17 points on the other end.

Emily Witkowski (*Michigan LHS*) and **Kati Aguilar** (*CLHS*) each finished with 14 points in the win, and Witkowski added 11 rebounds. **Cassandra Rose** (*KMLHS*) scored 11 points and grabbed a career-high 14 rebounds.
