

On September 30, 2006, the volleyball team capped a 4-0 weekend with a four-set win over Northwestern by the scores of 30-21, 30-24, 25-30, 30-26.

After defeating St. Scholastica (3-2), Northland (3-0), and Crown (3-0) earlier in the weekend, the Knights topped the Eagles 3-1, thanks to 20 kills and 25 digs from **Danielle Kramer** '07. **Shawna Mehlberg** '08 added 14 kills (only one error) and six blocks, while **Emily Buck** '07 finished with a match-best 55 assists to go with 21 digs.

That win over UNW is the most recent MLC win over the perennial UMAC power, and it also helped the Knights to the program's last UMAC regular season championship.
