On October 5, 2013, the MLC football team won a shootout against Iowa Wesleyan by the final score of 68-51.

Sophomore quarterback **Luke Rothe** '17 had a monster day on the ground and through the air in the win. Rothe rushed 30 times for 257 yards and three touchdowns, and also completed nine of his 13 pass attempts for 183 yards and four additional scores. **Micah Plocher** '14 caught six passes for 106 yards and two touchdowns, while **Matt Olson** '16 ran for 127 yards and two scores of his own.

MLC finished the 2013 season with a 4-6 record. Rothe accounted for 27 total touchdowns (18 passing, nine rushing) that season.
