## **Auxiliary Project Funding Starts Strong**

The MLC Ladies' Auxiliary project list includes three standing projects each year: scholarships (\$3,000), library materials (\$1,250), and outreach opportunities (\$2,500).

In addition, faculty, staff, and students are asked to submit projects not funded by their regular budgets. We are amazed at the variety of projects submitted from across so many departments of the college! This year's projects include travel assistance for student teachers, a 3-D printer, a baseball pitching screen, instrument microphones, dinnerware for events, and many more - totaling about \$26,000 for all the



projects.
