



Gosch Leads Knights to Win Over CSS

The women's basketball team defeated St. Scholastica 70-66 on Saturday, February 18, for its first win of the UMAC season.

Sophomore wing **Erika Gosch** (*GPLHS*) led the charge for MLC, scoring 20 of her career-high 23 points in the second half. Gosch shot 4-8 from beyond the three-point arc, and is now shooting a team-best 41.1 percent from downtown on the season.

Emma Nelson (*MVL*) recorded her first collegiate double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds. **Emily Witkowski** (*Michigan LHS*) added 15 points, while **Anna Treder** (*CLHS*) grabbed 11 rebounds.

The Knights overcame a six-point halftime deficit with a fast start to the second half on their way to building an eight-point lead. The Cougars chipped away at their deficit down the stretch, and finally took the lead with a pair of free throws with 21 seconds remaining. MLC had one last chance in the final seconds, but its shot to win the game rimmed out as the final buzzer sounded.

Micah Kieselhorst (*LPS*) scored 15 points to lead four MLC players in double figures. **Jack Heichelbech** (*LPS*) added 14 points, while **Jonathan Riebe** (*LPS*) and **Ezra Blumer** (*SCLA*) added 11 and 10 points, respectively, off the bench.
