

Knights Top Storm 86-56

The women's basketball team scored its first win of the season by the final of 86-56 over Crown College in non-conference action on Monday, February 1.

The Knights jumped out to a big lead early and never looked back as they held the Storm to 28.3 percent shooting from the field and forced 15 turnovers.

Erika Gosch (*GPLHS*) and **Emily Witkowski** (*Michigan LHS*) each finished with 15 points, while **Jordyn Heckendorf** (*KMLHS*) stuffed the stat sheet with 12 points, seven rebounds, and a team-high six assists. **Anna Treder** (*CLHS*) grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds to go with her six points.

The men's basketball team's season opener at North Central ended in heartbreaking fashion following a three-point buzzer-beater in a 93-92 defeat on January 26.

The Knights erased an 18-point deficit in the first half and came all the way back to finally take the lead in the final minutes, but were unable able to hold a four-point lead in the final seconds before the Rams stole the inbounds pass and made a 30-footer as the final buzzer sounded to score the win.

MLC followed that game with a pair of defeats to Northwestern-St. Paul and Bethany Lutheran. First-year wing **Ezra Blumer** (*SCLHS*) leads the Knights in scoring so far at 16.3 points per game. **Jack Heichelbech** (*LPS*) and **Joey Behm** (*KMLHS*) are also scoring in double figures at 14.0 and 10.5 points per game, respectively.
