The women's basketball team saw its season come to an end in the opening round of the UMAC Tournament with a 75-64 defeat at Bethany Lutheran.

The sixth-seeded Knights battled the third-seeded Vikings throughout the game and played one of its best games of the season. MLC trailed by only four points (54-50) heading into the fourth quarter and hung within striking distance until the final minutes, when BLC finally put the game away at the free throw line.

Sophomore **Erika Gosch** (*GPLHS*) led the Knights with a career-high 23 points, while senior **Emily Witkowski** (*Michigan LHS*) scored 15 points to go with five assists and four rebounds. Witkowski finished her career fourth in program history with 1,025 career points.
