Hoffman Breaks Softball Home Run Record

Sophomore first baseman **Elena Hoffman** (GPLHS) broke the MLC record with her 16th career home run on Monday, May 3, at Bethany Lutheran.

Hoffman tied the previous record of 15, held by Karla Opperman ('13), earlier this season and broke the record in the second game of the Knights' doubleheader at BLC.

Hoffman started her career in 2019 by tying the program's single-season record with eight home runs, and then smashed six homers in only ten games in 2020 before the season was canceled due to COVID-19. This season, Hoffman has a .364 batting average with 20 runs batted in and 15 runs scored. Hoffman ranks second in program history with a .385 career batting average.
