

## **Football Wins Season Finale 27-21**

The football team closed the 2021 season with a 27-21 comeback win against Northwestern-St. Paul on November 13.

The Knights honored 18 seniors playing their final game prior to the opening kickoff, and a number of them made the most of their last opportunity.

Joshuah Kren (*WISCO*) ran for 94 yards and three scores, including the game-winning two-yard touchdown with only nine seconds remaining in the fourth quarter. Ethan Aguilar (*CLHS*) completed 15 of 23 passes for 184 yards and one touchdown pass to Mike Radue (*WISCO*), who caught four passes for 38 yards. Noah Nordlie (*MLS*) led the defensive effort with three tackles for loss and one sack.

Seven members of the MLC men's and women's soccer teams earned All-UMAC honors last week.

Lucas Martin (*LPS*) and Xander Heiman (*LPS*) were both named Second Team All-UMAC for the men, while David Martin (*MLS*) received honorable mention. Lucas Martin and Heiman led MLC in goals with 11 and eight, respectively, this season. David Martin started all 18 games this season, primarily on defense.

**Hannah Schroeder** (*LPS*) and **Anna Borgwardt** (*WLA*) earned Second Team All-UMAC honors for the women, with **Lilianne Zimpelmann** (*LPS*) and **Nicole Porter** (*MVL*) winning honorable mention. Schroeder led the team in scoring (five goals, 12 points), while Borgwardt was a key contributor on defense. Porter led the team with five assists. Zimpelmann scored twice and played several roles in her debut season.

## **Men's Basketball Suffers Tough Defeat at Concordia**

The men's basketball team overcame a halftime deficit, but could not complete the comeback in a 66-64 loss at Concordia-Moorhead on November 13.
