

Offensive Explosion Leads Men to 87-70 Win Over UMM

The men's basketball team overcame an eight-point halftime deficit by outscoring Minnesota Morris 54-29 in the second half of an 87-70 win on Friday, February 11.


After shooting 34.1 percent in the first half, the Knights shot 67.7 percent from the field and made six of 10 attempts from beyond the three-point arc in the second half. **Ezra Blumer** (*SCLA*) led the charge for MLC with 22 points, including 15 in the second half. Blumer also led the team with 10 rebounds to secure his first career double-double.

Jack Heichelbech (*LPS*), **Micah Kieselhorst** (*LPS*), and **Joseph Hirsch** (*LPS*) all joined Blumer in double figures. **Joey Behm** (*KMLHS*) and **Jacob Price** (*Northland Lutheran*) combined for 15 points, five assists, and five rebounds off the bench.

Softball Set to Open Season This Weekend



The softball team opens the 2022 season with a doubleheader on Saturday, February 19, against Carleton College in the Dundas Dome.

The Knights are coming off a strong 2021 campaign in which they finished sixth in the UMAC with an 8-8 conference record. While the Knights must replace their top two pitchers from last year, they return a number of key contributors at the plate to help lead the charge this season.

Among the returners is Lisa Hoffer (*West Lutheran*), who was named First Team All-UMAC and First Team All-Region last season after batting .462 with four home runs and 32 runs batted in. Senior Elena Hoffman (*GPLHS*) returns after breaking the MLC program record last season with 17 career home runs, while Kylie Wolf (*FVL*) and Jordyn Heckendorf (*KMLHS*) also return as starters in the outfield.
