Gimel = gim'-l (hard G as in 'go')

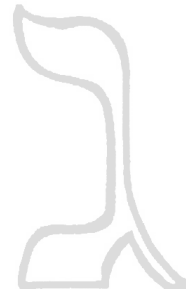
2. Trace them, color them, or try to write them yourself.
