The women's tennis team defeated Bethany Lutheran College 6-3 on Tuesday, April 19, for its first win of the season.

The Knights started strong by winning two of three doubles matches. The number-two team of **Charis Glende** (*LPS*) and **Sarah Hoffe** (*Luther*) won 8-3, while the number-three team of **Katie Kutz** (*Luther*) and **Abigail Schewe** (*LPS*) won 8-0.

In singles, Glende and Hoffe each won their matches to finish the day with two points apiece. **McKenzy Crowley** (*Rapid City SD*) won in the number-one spot 6-3 and 6-4, while **Hannah Broring** (*LPS*) won her number-six match 6-0 and 6-0 to finish off the team win.

He improved on that average in a game against Crown College on Tuesday, April 19, with two more hits and is currently hitting .471 for the season to go along with six doubles, 17 runs scored, 10 runs batted in, and a .540 on-base percentage. Cox leads the Knights in each of those statistics this season.
