



Wolf Gets 1000th Set Assist

Knight **Kylie Wolf** (*FVL*) reached a landmark goal for volleyball players when she recorded her 1000th set assist this past weekend. Kylie had 990 set assists going into the match and had 15 in the Crown match to put her at 1005.

For her career, she had 229 assists in 2020, 400 assists in 2021, and 376 so far in 2022. She currently ranks 9th in all-time set assists at MLC.

“Kylie has been a great leader on and off the court,” said Coach Emma Holzhueter. “It’s great to see her hard work pay off with this achievement.”

Kylie is set to graduate this spring and will be taking a call. She’s looking forward to perhaps passing on her love of sports to the next generation via coaching. Kylie credits her liberos, back row players, and front row players for helping her reach this milestone. “That’s what makes volleyball great,” she said, “working toward a common goal.”

Habben has cut significant time—almost 45 seconds—off last year’s events.
