

## **MLC Battles Crown but Falls 61-54**



The women's basketball team faced off against Crown on Friday, January 20. The Knights overcame a 10-point deficit at halftime, tying the game at 51-51 in the second half, but were unable to come away with the victory. They fell to the Polars 61-54.

The Knights' rally was highlighted by a trio of 3-pointers in the second half. **Jordyn Heckendorf** (*KML*, *pictured*) got things going with a 3-pointer from the top of the key, while **Kortney Behnke** (*FVL*) hit a 3-pointer off the backboard, and **Emma Nelson** (*MVL*) connected on a pull-up triple off the dribble that eventually tied the game.

The Polars showed their composure in the final minutes and iced the game with a layup from Isabelle Sager that came off a Madi Hecox drive to the basket. Crown then took advantage of MLC fouling a 3-point shooter and hit all three free-throws to seal the seven-point win.

Despite the loss, MLC gave a gutsy performance and hung tough without two key players—Lydia Feidt (*FVL*) and Lauren Paulsen

(LPS), who were out due to injury. The Knights were led by Heckendorf's double-double, as she scored 14 points and grabbed 14 rebounds.
