The MLC men's basketball team defeated Maranatha Baptist 76-58 for their second win of the season on Tuesday, January 24.

The first half saw several lead changes, but MLC went into the locker room up 37-32 after **Micah Kieselhorst** (*LPS*, *pictured*) connected on a 3-pointer from the top of the key.

The women's basketball team had an impressive 60-33 win against Maranatha Baptist on Tuesday, January 24. The Knights ramped up their defensive pressure from the beginning, forcing 25 turnovers in the first half. Despite shooting only 33 percent as a team, MLC found themselves up 33-13 at the break.

MLC continued that defensive intensity in the second half and cruised to the double-digit victory. The Knights forced a season-high in turnovers (39) and allowed their lowest point total of the season (33).

**Grace Kieselhorst** (*LPS, pictured*) led the Knights with 13 points, despite fouling out at the start of the fourth quarter. **Jordyn Heckendorf** (*KML*) added 11 points and four rebounds for MLC.
