Could I Be a Pastor? This coloring book tells the story of Joe, who visits his pastor at church to talk about all the things a pastor does and how he might become a pastor—which includes going to Martin Luther College!

Could I Be a Teacher? This coloring book tells the story of Alicia, who talks to her teacher about how to become a teacher—which includes going to Martin Luther College!

Optional uses:

- Use each book as a read-aloud or a read-together.
- Print the books and let the children color them.
- Use the discussion questions at the back of each book to help the students think more deeply about the important work of being a Lutheran pastor or teacher.
- Consider sharing your own story—how and why you became a teacher. Include any positive stories about your time at MLC!
- Consider asking your pastor to share how and why he became a pastor. The children could
 meet him in the church or at his office. He might also show them the Bible in Hebrew and
 Greek—and talk to them about his time at MLC (or NWC) and the Seminary!
