Habben Breaks MLC Record at Gustavus Meet

Maya Habben (*LPS*, *pictured*) carried over her success from the indoor season into the outdoor, placing first in the 3000-Meter Steeplechase at the Gustavus Invitational on Sunday, April 23.

The junior had a mark of 12:18.99, which broke an MLC school record in the event. Habben surpassed the previous record of 12:34.84 held by **Rebecca Boehlke** '19.

The Knights had another first-place finish in the Javelin Throw from Erika


Gosch (*GPL*). The senior had a top throw of 34.39 meters, which edged out the second-place thrower by almost two full meters.
