Schoeneck, Schroeder Earn UMAC Player of the Week

First-years **Rebekah Schroeder** (*LPS, pictured far left*) and **Katie Schoeneck** (*LPS, pictured left*) were each named UMAC Women's Soccer Player of the Week on Monday afternoon after their games against Dakota Wesleyan on Wednesday and Buena Vista on Saturday.

Schroeder recorded a total of 19 saves in the two games and earned her first career shutout on Saturday against the Beavers, locking down the attack from Buena Vista.

Schoeneck earned the offensive player honors particularly after her performance against Buena Vista, where she scored two goals in the first period to guide the Knights to their first win of the season. The forward also had a total of three shots on goal in both games.

Cox Has Career Day Against Macalester

Senior **Mason** *Cox* (*MVL*, *pictured*) had an impressive game on Saturday, September 9, in the football team's home opener against Macalester.

The wide receiver recorded four receptions and a career-high in receiving yards (186) and receiving touchdowns (3) to keep the Knights competitive in the game.

Though the game ended in a 56-27 loss, Cox excelled, opening the game with a 71-yard touchdown catch on the opening play from scrimmage and following that with another deep touchdown reception on MLC's next drive.

Men's Soccer Claws Past Beavers

The men's soccer team won their second game of the season in a 2-1 defeat of the Buena Vista Beavers on Saturday, September 9. Though Buena Vista controlled possession for the majority of the second period, MLC's defense was able to hold off their attack.

Josiah Wordell (*KML*) and Nathan Pausma (*WLA*) scored a goal apiece, while Adam Rosenbaum (*Michigan LHS*) recorded 10 saves for MLC.
