



Defense Anchors Knights in Win Over Crown

The football team won their second consecutive game in a defensive battle against the Crown Polars by a final score of 13-3 on Saturday, October 21.

The Knights defense held the UMAC passing leader, Diego Narezo, to just 208 yards through the air and gave up season-lows in points allowed (3) and yards from scrimmage (286).

“Crown’s passing offense presented a lot of challenges for us coming in,” said Head Coach **Paul Huebner**, “but I thought our defensive coaches did a tremendous job preparing our guys this week.”

Max Nordlie (*MLS*) punched in a rushing touchdown in the first quarter, while **Micah Koschnitzke** (*WISCO*) connected on two field goals in the final five minutes.

Zach Arndt (*SCLA, pictured*) rushed for 105 yards on 16 carries, stepping up to fill the shoes of **Carson Oestreich** (*Pierce NE*), who’s injured.

Mason Cox (*MVL*) led the MLC receivers with five receptions and 121 yards.
