
## Cox Earns Player of the Week in Florida

The baseball team picked up three wins on their Florida trip, including a 29-11 win over Alfred University on Tuesday, March 5, and a doubleheader sweep over Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts on Friday, March 8. The Knights' 29 runs against Alfred were the most in a game in the Randy Cox coaching era.

**Mason Cox** (MVL, pictured) won UMAC player of the week for his impressive performance at the RussMatt Invitational, going 22-for-38 (.579 BA) with two HR, 17 RBI, and four triples in 10 games played. In the win over Alfred, Cox went 7-for-7 at the plate with nine RBI and two triples, and broke the MLC career home run record (9).

**Spencer Lilienthal** (Glencoe-Silver Lake MN) and **Parker Winghart** (LPS) also found success at the top of the lineup. Lilienthal went 14-for-35 (.400 BA) with eight RBI and 12 runs scored, while Winghart batted .342 with 10 RBI and nine runs scored.

## **Softball Pulls Off Comeback Win**

The softball team won two games on Thursday, March 7, in Myrtle Beach, defeating Lancaster Bible College 10-2 and winning in wild and dramatic fashion over Albion College 11-10.

With Albion leading 10-3, the Knights exploded for an eight-run seventh inning, scoring six runs with two outs in the final frame to complete the comeback win. **Lisa Hoffer** (West, pictured) topped off the rally with a walk-off double.





## **Plocher Is All-American in High Jump**

**Samuel Plocher** (Evergreen, pictured) finished eighth overall in the high jump at the DIII Indoor Track and Field Championships in Virginia Beach on Saturday, March 9.

The first-year jumped 2.04 meters in the finals, which put him in a tie with five other jumpers and made him the first MLC student-athlete since Todd Brassow *MLC '16* to claim All-American status.
