In celebration of the tenth anniversary of the Thalassa prize, the award will be doubled to \$2000.

This award is given to recognize a Martin Luther College student or graduate who expresses clearly and beautifully, in image and word, a personal reflection on a ministry experience overseas.

Purposes of the MLC Thalassa Prize

- To express gratitude to God for the opportunity to serve him in international venues.
- To provide an opportunity for MLC students and graduates in international ministry to share their stories.
- To motivate and inspire current MLC students to consider serving overseas.
- To bring glory to God through excellence in the arts of photography and creative writing.
- To reaffirm through image and word the dignity of the entire human race and the desire of God to save all people.

Entrance Requirements

- Open to all MLC undergraduates and graduates who have done ministry or are doing ministry outside the United States
- Each entry must include
 - A completed entry form (found at www.mlc-wels.edu/go/thalassa)
 - o A color digital photograph taken in a world mission field
 - o A personal reflection on ministry in that world mission field
- Entrants may submit as many entries as they wish
- Deadline for all submissions: April 15, 2016

Prize

- The *Thalassa Prize* recipient will be announced in May 2016
- The \$2000 prize will be divided equally between the winner (\$1000) and an international mission of the winner's choice (\$1000).

Contest Guidelines

Submission Rules:

- All submissions should include a completed entry form, a digital photograph, and a written reflection
- All submissions should be emailed to gaugerlf@mlc-wels.edu
- The photograph should
 - Be taken in the foreign mission field in which you serve(d)
 - Be clearly related to the submitted written reflection
 - Be taken by you, not a third party
 - Be either a color or black and white digital
 - Be submitted as a large JPG at high resolution
 - NOT be panoramic
 - NOT be "photo-shopped" or enhanced (The following small enhancements ARE allowed: red-eye removal, cropping, rotating, and one-step auto enhancement.)
- The written reflection should
 - Tell a story about your ministry (Examples: a blessing from God received, a lesson learned, a moving experience, an inspiring moment, etc.)
 - Have a title
 - Be clearly related to the submitted photograph
 - Be written by you, not a third party
 - Be not more than 300 words (no exceptions)
- Entrants may submit as many entries as they wish, each with a separate entry form
- **Deadline** for all submissions: April 15, 2016

Judging Criteria:

- The photograph will be judged on the basis of
 - o Effectiveness in conveying the intended message regarding overseas ministry
 - o Quality of image (composition, clarity, color)
 - o Style, creativity, originality
- The reflection/narrative will be judged on the basis of
 - o Effectiveness in conveying the intended message regarding overseas ministry
 - Quality of writing (content and mechanics)
 - o Style, creativity, originality
- The evaluation committee will consist of MLC professors / staff who are involved with *Daylight International* (international teaching opportunities) and are qualified judges of writing and photography
- **Tip:** Although overseas landmarks and landscapes may be very beautiful, submissions should reflect the human element of ministry—real people, real stories, real lives.

Prize

- The \$2000 prize will be divided equally between the winner (\$1000) and an international mission of the winner's choice (\$1000).
- The winner will also receive a commemorative plaque.
- The winning submission may be published in MLC and WELS publications, posted online, and displayed on campus.
